- 1. The race is a flat rural 10K along minor roads and tracks. Most of the roads are closed.
- 2. Limited parking(weather permitting), changing (no showers), supper and presentation are at Ovingham Middle School. The school will be open from 6pm. The start line is approx one mile from the school.
- 3. Please try to stand in a starting place appropriate to your race speed as the start is narrow.
- 4. The George Ogle Memorial Mile prizes are awarded to the first male and female past the 1 mile marker, who complete the race.
- 5. After the race there will be a pie and pea supper (included in the entry fee) followed by the prize presentation. There will be generous prizes in senior and veteran categories. There will also be team prizes. Club vests must be worn for team competition.
- 6. NOTE: NO RUNNER MAY CLAIM MORE THAN ONE INDIVIDUAL PRIZE.

- Only one prize per runner and team prizes. Club vests must be worn for team prizes.
