IMPORTANT NOTES

- Entries from Clubs will only be accepted if the Club is currently affiliated to Northern Athletics and England Athletics. Team members **MUST** be first claim members of that club **AND** registered with England Athletics. **England Athletics Registration Numbers MUST be included. Athletes without registration numbers will not be entered.**
- Entries must be submitted online or on the official entry form with the correct fees
- Late & incorrectly submitted entries will not be accepted and will be returned
- Acknowledgement of entry and final instructions will only be sent to those Clubs that submit a SAE with entry
- Clubs that knowingly run ineligible or unregistered runners will be disqualified and may have their entry refused for the 2010 event
- All Northern Athletics Clubs (*former NoEAA territory*) affiliated to England Athletics are eligible to enter the 2009 National Championships
