RESULTS

RULES

- 1. First claim members only.
- 2. Affiliated athletic clubs only.
- 3. Entry is open to all master athletes of affiliated clubs, whether or not they belong to a master only club.
- 4. Older age groups may compete in a younger age group event, but may only run once.
- 5. No athlete may run more than one stage.
- 6. Club vests must be worn.
- 7. Race numbers for the appropriate stage MUST be worn on the front and back and MUST be worn as issued and not cut or folded.
- 8. All athletes must wear on the back an age category number as issued.
- 9. Ages are as on day of race.
- 10. Clubs may enter up to three times the number entitled to compete in each age group race.
- 11. Teams and running order are to be declared 30 minutes before the start of the first stage. i.e. either 10.30 am or 12.30 pm as appropriate.
- 12. Only one team per club per age group will be allowed to enter. i.e. No 'B' teams.
- 13. Only entries on the official entry form will be accepted.
- 14. Competitors entering these championships do so on the understanding they abide by the UKA rules, and compete at their own risk; and that the organisers are in no way to be held responsible for injury, accident, damage or loss incurred.
- 15. Closing date 17th April 2010. NO LATE OR TELEPHONE ENTRIES
